# SolidView 2020.0 Release Notes

## 1. Windows 7 End Of Service

---

SolidView is fully compatible with Windows 10, and therefore can be installed and used in computers that have Windows 10. Beginning our 2021 release, Windows 7 will no longer be supported.

## 2. Updated CAD Interface Support

---

We have updated our CAD interfaces to their latest versions. These updates also include bug fixes and enhancements. Some of the CAD interfaces we have updated are:

## 3. End-Of-Life Notice

### CAD Interface Support

Beginning SolidView 2019, the following file formats will no longer be supported:

- AutoCAD DXF/DWG
- SDRC Web Access (mca, idi files)

### Supported Operative Systems

Beginning SolidView 2021, Windows 7 is no longer supported. Only the following Operative Systems are currently supported:

- Windows 8 and 8.1 x64
- Windows 10 x64

## 5. Installing, Uninstalling, and Upgrade Notes

During your installation you can choose between TYPICAL or CUSTOM installation types<sup>3</sup>:

- COMPLETE installation installs all CAD interfaces (only purchased interfaces are usable)
- CUSTOM installation allows you to choose which CAD interfaces to install

3. This applies to SolidView/Pro and SolidView/Pro RP versions only, SolidView/Lite and SolidView do not have optional CAD interfaces available.
